## TRANSCRIPT INFORMATION

All grades that appear on the transcript are un-weighted. The weighting factor is reflected in the GPA. Bishop Lynch does not use Physical Education grades when calculating the GPA. The fall semester of band and dance/drill team, as well as cheerleading are considered PE courses. Dance can be either a Fine Art or PE course. This is reflected in the course title.

## GRADING SYSTEM

Bishop Lynch High School uses a numeric grading system on a 100-point scale. Credit is awarded for a semester grade of 70 or above. A semester consists of two nine-week quarters. Students may receive a “final pass” for earning a 77 or higher in the spring semester following a fall failure in math, foreign language and chemistry courses only.
