


STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

4. Enter all courses on your Course Selection Worksheet.
-  5. **After your courses are added, add 1 or 2 Alternate courses.**
6. When finished adding all classes and alternates, click "**Submit**" at bottom.
7. Do you have any **red error messages** saying you don't have the prerequisite to request some of your classes? If so, please circle those classes on your Course Selection Worksheet, and take it to a counselor.
8. Log out.
9. Turn in your worksheet to your counselor. **If you have courses which you could not enter, your counselor will override the error messages and add them for you.**

TECHNOLOGY CLASSES

One technology credit is required at BL. You may take additional courses as electives. All courses are one semester (1/2 credit) except AP Computer Science, which is a full year (1 credit). You may choose from the following:

- **611-Computer Applications—Word and PowerPoint.** Take this class if you need a *brush-up on the basics*. You may take this class in person or online. It is offered on-ground and online during the summer, fall, and spring. Online courses are for rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors.
- **612-Office Applications—Excel.** Take this class if you enjoy *numbers and formulas*. This class may also be taken in person or online. It is offered both on-ground and in person during the fall and spring and online during the summer for rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors.
- **614-Desktop Publishing—Adobe Photoshop and InDesign.** Take this class if you want to use your artistic flair to *edit photos and design documents* such as brochures, newsletters, business cards, etc.
- **615-Website Design – Adobe Dreamweaver.** Take this course if you have a creative bent and want to *design your own website* on the subject of your choice.
- **619-Programming for Gaming—Alice.** Take this entry level programming course for an introduction to *software engineering and animations*.
- **622-AP Computer Science A—**Take this course if you are at least a sophomore, have completed Geometry and Programming for Gaming, and are considering a major in computer science, engineering, physics, or chemistry. Upon completion, you can take the AP exam for college credit.
- **623-Robotic Technology—**Take on the role of mechanical engineer, computer scientist, and electrical engineer and work in teams creating robots!
